

ASSEMBLY


The assembly commenced promptly at 6:00 AM. Attendance was taken, and the punctuality of volunteers was closely monitored, with latecomers marked separately.






ILLAM VISIT




GAMES

Food committee provided food at 12:30 pm. The menu was meals with cabbage,pappadam and pickle. All volunteers came and had their food. It ended at 1:15pm






Movie show
